- From 1912 "Peking University"
- Disciplinary Relocation in 1952
- Centennial Anniversary in 1998
 ---- Defined the goal to be world-class in the 21st century
- Merged with Beijing Medical University in 2000
- New College of Engineering in 2006










3,173 Projects in Natural, Engineering & Medical Sciences in 2009




